NSU camping weekend at historic motorcycle races.

TT demo rides Haler

Historic Motor Races themed to the NSU brand In the weekend of July 13-16, 2023.

A demonstration race weekend will be held at the village of Haler, near Weert in the southeast of the Netherlands, for classic motorcycles and sidecars. This is an excellent opportunity to enjoy classic racing motorcycles such as NSU but also many other brands. (For the website see <https://www.ttdemohaler.nl>)

If someone owns a historic race or sports bike, it is possible to participate in the Demonstration (regularity) races. In this case please contact the Dutch NSU Club for details.(see below)

The circuit consists of a number of closed country roads near the village of Haler. Motorcycles attending are from the thirties to the seventies. The program starts on Friday evening with a 2 hour demo race. On Saturday and Sunday there are heats for all classes during the day. Catering is available as well as a large tent for Saturday evening celebrations.

In 2023, NSU will be the theme brand to which extra attention will be paid. Members of NSU clubs are invited to attend this weekend. NSU cars are welcome too!

Program

Arrival on Friday during the day.

On Friday evening there is a tour of the original TT circuit from 1938-1939 of about 12 km. The (racing) motorcycles and classic cars (including all NSUs) can participate in this with the guidance of traffic controllers.

A 2-hour race for historic motorcycles is also held on Friday evening on the current circuit.

On Saturday, the HVM runs with engines up to about 1968, Sunday is provided by the CRT with partly more modern engines up to about 1975.

Depart Sunday evening, or Monday morning

NSU club participation

If we have more than 30 participants, a private camping site will be made available to us with electricity, toilet and shower facilities. This area is located on the circuit at Start and Finish, opposite the riders' quarters. Of course we would like an NSU field, so sign up quickly!

If there are fewer than 30 participants, we will be accommodated in the riders' quarters. There are no showers there.

Catering, toilets, a large tent and a museum tent are available at the riders' quarters.

Nearby is also accommodation for those who do not camp.

Cost

Costs are per participant (2 persons) € 55, = for the weekend including access to the riders quarters and the races. Children up to 12 years free. Extra entrance tickets € 5.00 per day or € 7.50 for the weekend.

Response requested

In order to determine whether we will be accommodated in the riders quarter or on our own camping site, we would like to know who is interested in coming to this weekend.

Based on this number of registrations, we can decide whether we should set up our own site.
